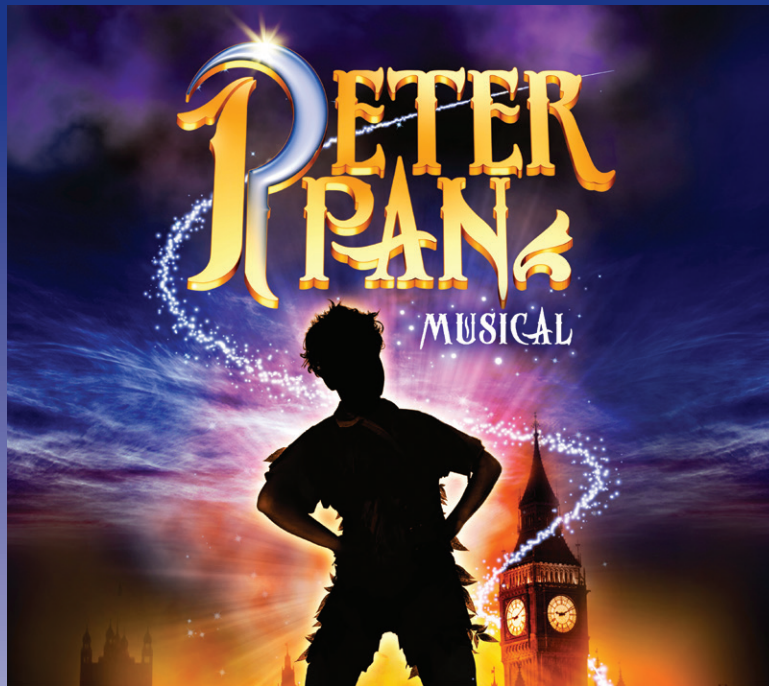

Synopsis

PETER PAN

The famous boy who never grows old, Peter Pan is boastful and carefree; self-centred and oblivious; forgetful and fearless.



CAPTAIN HOOK

The Captain of the Jolly Roger ship. Hook's right hand was severed in a duel with Peter, and an iron hook now occupies the stump.



WENDY

Eldest child and only daughter of the Darling family. The "mother" figure to both Peter Pan and The Lost Boy.



JOHN DARLING

The middle child of the Darling family. Fascinated by pirates, John dreams of his independence.



MICHAEL DARLING

The youngest of the Darling family (probably around 5). Daydreams of living in a wigwam.



THE LOST BOYS

The Lost Boys follow Peter's leadership, and are seemingly banished from Neverland when they grow up.



MR. SMEE

He is Captain Hook's loyal first mate, though his bumbling behavior often prevents him from being much help.



TIGER LILY

She is the guardian of the woodland realm, revered by the creatures of Neverland for her compassion and her fierce protection of their shared home.
