LATEST WARREN MILLER WINTER SPORTS FILM “HERE, THERE AND EVERYWHERE” IS ONE COOL EVENING

FORT LAUDERDALE – The Broward Center for the Performing Arts and Peter Glenn Ski will present **Warren Miller’s latest epic ski adventure film, *Here, There & Everywhere***, in the Amaturio Theater on **Friday, November 18 at 8:30 p.m.**

The 67th full-length feature film from the most respected name in action-sports film production also will include onscreen the original cinematographer, narrator and household name, Warren Miller.

Original ski bum and adventure film pioneer Miller began capturing the wonder, the adventure, the humor and the beauty that is skiing in 1949.
